



Dual Credit/Enrollment Policy

The New America School –Las Cruces and Dona Ana Community College (Post-secondary institution) have entered into a Memorandum of Agreement for Concurrent Enrollment and Dual Credit Programs.

This MOU establishes student and course eligibility to enter into the Dual Credit Program, which are college-level courses offered by DACC prior to high school graduation. Students may earn credit toward high school credit completion and a post-secondary degree or certificate simultaneously as defined by NMAC 6. 30.7.

Within the Dual Credit Program, courses may be academic or career technical, but may not be remedial or developmental. Within this program, DACC will waive tuition and general fees and The New America School- Las Cruces will pay for books applicable to the course of concurrent enrollment in accordance with NMAC 6.30.7. NAS-LC will transcript credit earned from DACC upon receipt of an official grade or transcript record from DACC. All DACC guidelines must be adhered to according to the MOU.

Books that are purchased for the program must be returned to the school. Special fees and other materials needed for the program will be considered on a needed basis. Classes that are selected must be outside of the regular school day.
